

GENERAL INFORMATION
VILLAGE OF VANSCOY

Building Permits

- required by any person building a structure larger than 10X10 feet
- building permit applications must be filled out completely and turned into the Village Office for review at a council meeting; permit applications must be accompanied by two sets of plans
- relevant sections from the Zoning Bylaw will be provided for site requirements and lot lines; as well as garage construction regulations
- no building is permitted until the application is approved and the appropriate fee is paid

Business License

- required by anyone carrying on business in the Village
- Home-Based business/home occupations require licenses
- licenses are to be renewed January 1 of each year

Dog Licenses

- required for any type or age of dog
- licenses are to be renewed January 1 of each year
- \$15 when renewed in January; \$30 for late registrations

Waste/Recycling

- the Village does not have a landfill for household waste; Loraas Disposal is responsible for the collection of waste (Wednesday for the business bins; Thursday for residential carts)
- blue bins are provided for recycling and are picked up every other Thursday (alternately with the waste pickup)
- leaves, branches and garden waste is to be placed in the alley for pickup; seasonal public works personnel is contracted from May to October (weather permitting)

Other Information

- the Village requires that back water gate valves be installed on every fixture drain connected to a building drain or branch when the fixture is located below the level of the adjoining street; where the fixture is a floor drain, a removable cap may be installed on the upstream side of the trap; and where more than one fixture is located in one room and all are connected to the same branch, the gate valve or backwater valve shall be installed on the branch
- the Village requires that the owner of a newly constructed structure with a subsurface drainage system shall install a sump pump and surface discharge system to allow discharge to the surface; discharge shall not be directed onto a ground surface within 2 meters of any building; and discharge shall be directed to the front yard of the property
- the owner of a lot on any street will be responsible for any damage to curbs, curb stops, concrete or paved surfaces due to oversize vehicles or delivery vehicles to their property
